The election is carried out in the following way:

Right to vote:

- 1. All congregation members over the age of 16 who have received the sacrament of confirmation and are registered in the parish have the right to vote.
- 2. Voting period You may vote for the period Saturday 24 March -Wednesday 11 April 2018 until 18:30 hours.
- 3. You are entitled to anonymity as for whom you are voting.
- 4. The church council / parish priest designates those who will carry out the counting of the election.

How do you proceed?

- 1. There shall be elected four members and two deputy members to the Parish Council.
- 2. Therefore, cross the name of up to six people you wish to elect.
- 3. You may vote for fewer candidates, but not more than six crosses.
- 4. The checked ballot paper is then placed in a blank envelope, which is closed.
- 5. Then put the blank envelope in another envelope that is sealed. (Glued).
- 6. On the outer envelope, enter the name and address and date of birth of the person who has cast the vote (write clearly, those names not legible will not be counted
- 7. If several people use the same envelope, the names of all those using this envelope must be identifiable no one may to vote more than once.
- 8. The names printed on the outermost envelope are then checked with the parish member registry.
- 9. Checked envelopes are opened and the blank envelopes are collected in a stack that is mixed together to ensure anonymity.

Crossed over names, accumulations and applying a new name to the ballot papers, makes the vote invalid. Votes can be given per. mail or by using the election box that is located at the back of the church.
