# Reading 1, Exodus 34:4-6, 8-9

So he cut two tablets of stone like the first and, with the two tablets of stone in his hands, <u>Moses</u> went up Mount <u>Sinai</u> in the early morning as <u>Yahweh</u> had

ordered. And <u>Yahweh</u> descended in a cloud and stood with him there and pronounced the name

Yahweh. Then <u>Yahweh</u> passed before him and called out, 'Yahweh, Yahweh, <u>God</u> of tenderness and compassion, slow to anger, rich in faithful love and constancy, Moses immediately bowed to the ground in worship, then he said, 'If indeed I do enjoy your favour, please, my Lord, come with us, although they are an obstinate people; and forgive our faults and sins, and adopt us as your heritage.'

## Gospel, *John 3:16-18*

For this is how <u>God</u> loved the world: he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life. For <u>God</u> sent his Son into the world not to judge the world, but so that through him the world might be saved. No one who believes in him <u>will</u> be judged; but whoever does not believe is judged already, because that <u>person</u> does not believe in the Name of God's only Son.
