Daily Reading for Sunday, December 20th, 2020

Reading 1, Second Samuel 7:1-5, 8-11, 16

¹ Once the king had settled into his palace and Yahweh had granted him rest from all the enemies surrounding him, ² the king said to the <u>prophet</u> Nathan, 'Look, I am living in a cedar-wood palace, while the ark of God is under awnings.' 3 Nathan said to the king, 'Go and do whatever you have in mind, for Yahweh is with you.' 4 But that very night, the word of Yahweh came to Nathan: 5 'Go and tell my servant David, "Yahweh says this: Are you to build me a temple for me to live in? ⁸ This is what you must say to my servant David, "Yahweh Sabaoth says this: I took you from the pasture, from following the sheep, to be leader of my people Israel; 9 I have been with you wherever you went; I have got rid of all your enemies for you. I am going to make your fame as great as the fame of the greatest on earth. ¹⁰ I am going to provide a place for my people Israel; I shall plant them there, and there they will live and never be disturbed again; nor will they be oppressed by the wicked any more, as they were in former times 11 ever since the time when I instituted judges to govern my people Israel; and I shall grant you rest from all your enemies. Yahweh furthermore tells you that he will make you a dynasty. 16 Your dynasty and your sovereignty will ever stand firm before me and your throne be for ever secure." '

² for you have said: love is built to last for ever, you have fixed your constancy firm in the heavens. ³ 'I have made a covenant with my Chosen One, sworn an oath to my servant David: ⁴ I have made your dynasty firm for ever, built your <u>throne</u> stable age after age. ⁵ The heavens praise your wonders, Yahweh, your constancy in the gathering of your faithful.

²⁷ So I shall make him my first-born, the highest of earthly kings. ²⁹ I have established his dynasty for ever, his <u>throne</u> to be as lasting as the heavens.

Reading 2, *Romans 16:25-27*

²⁵ And now to him who can make you strong in accordance with the gospel that I preach and the proclamation of <u>Jesus</u> Christ, in accordance with that <u>mystery</u> which for endless ages was kept secret ²⁶ but now (as the prophets wrote) is revealed, as the eternal <u>God</u> commanded, to be made known to all the nations, so that they obey in faith: ²⁷ to him, the only wise God, give <u>glory</u> through <u>Jesus Christ</u> for ever and ever. Amen.

Gospel, *Luke 1:26-38*

²⁶ In the sixth month the <u>angel</u> Gabriel was sent by God to a town in Galilee called Nazareth, ²⁷ to a virgin betrothed to a man named Joseph, of the House of David; and the virgin's name was Mary. ²⁸ He went in and said to her, 'Rejoice, you who enjoy God's favour! The Lord is with you.' ²⁹ She was deeply disturbed by these words and asked herself what this greeting could mean, 30 but the angel said to her, 'Mary, do not be afraid; you have won God's favour. 31 Look! You are to conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you must name him Jesus. 32 He will be great and will be called Son of the Most High. The Lord God will give him the throne of his ancestor David; 33 he will rule over the House of <u>Jacob</u> for ever and his reign <u>will</u> have no end.' ³⁴ Mary said to the angel, 'But how can this come about, since I have no knowledge of man?'

³⁵ The <u>angel</u> answered, 'The <u>Holy Spirit will</u> come upon you, and the power of the Most High <u>will</u> cover you with its shadow. And so the child <u>will</u> be holy and <u>will</u> be called Son of God. ³⁶ And I tell you this too: your cousin <u>Elizabeth</u> also, in her old age, has conceived a son, and she whom people called barren is now in her sixth month, ³⁷ for nothing is impossible to God.' ³⁸ Mary said, 'You see before you the Lord's servant, let it happen to me as you have said.' And the <u>angel</u> left her.
