Daily Reading for Sunday, February 14th, 2021

Reading 1, Leviticus 13:1-2, 44-46

- ¹ Yahweh said to <u>Moses</u> and Aaron,² 'If a swelling or scab or spot appears on someone's skin, which could develop into a contagious skin-disease, that <u>person</u> must then be taken to the priest, either <u>Aaron</u> or one of his sons.
- the <u>person</u> has such a disease: he is unclean. The <u>priest will</u> declare him unclean; he has a contagious skin-disease of the head. ⁴⁵ 'Anyone with a contagious skin-disease <u>will</u> wear torn <u>clothing</u> and disordered hair; and <u>will</u> cover the upper lip and shout, "Unclean, unclean." ⁴⁶ As long as the disease lasts, such a <u>person will</u> be unclean and, being unclean, <u>will</u> live alone and live outside the camp.

Responsorial Psalm, Psalms 32:1-2, 5, 11

- ¹ [Of David Poem] How blessed are those whose offence is forgiven, whose <u>sin</u> blotted out. ² How blessed are those to whom <u>Yahweh</u> imputes no guilt, whose <u>spirit</u> harbours no deceit.
- ⁵ I made my <u>sin</u> known to you, did not conceal my guilt. I said, 'I shall confess my offence to Yahweh.' And you, for your part, took away my guilt, forgave my sin.
- ¹¹ Rejoice in Yahweh, exult all you upright, shout for joy, you honest of heart.

Reading 2, First Corinthians 10:31-11:1

Whatever you eat, then, or drink, and whatever else you do, do it all for the glory of God. ³² Never be a <u>cause</u> of offence, either to <u>Jews</u> or to Greeks or to the Church of God, ³³ just as I try to accommodate everybody in everything, not looking for my own advantage, but for the advantage of everybody else, so that they may be saved. ¹ Take me as your pattern, just as I take <u>Christ</u> for mine.

Gospel, *Mark 1:40-45*

⁴⁰ A <u>man</u> suffering from a virulent skin-disease came to him and pleaded on his knees saying, 'If you are willing, you can cleanse me.' ⁴¹ Feeling sorry for him, <u>Jesus</u> stretched out his hand, touched him and said to him, 'I am willing. Be cleansed.' ⁴² And at once the skin-disease left him and he was cleansed. ⁴³ And at once <u>Jesus</u> sternly sent him away and said to him, ⁴⁴ 'Mind you tell no one anything, but go and show yourself to the priest, and make the offering for your cleansing prescribed by <u>Moses</u> as evidence to them.' ⁴⁵ The <u>man</u> went away, but then started freely proclaiming and telling the story everywhere, so that <u>Jesus</u> could no longer go openly into any town, but stayed outside in deserted places. Even so, people from all around kept coming to him.
