Reading Isaiah 63,7-9

⁷ I shall recount Yahweh's <u>acts</u> of faithful love, Yahweh's praises, in return for all that <u>Yahweh</u> has done for us, for his great kindness to the House of Israel, for all that he has done in his mercy, for the abundance of his <u>acts</u> of faithful love.
⁸ For he said, 'Truly they are my people, <u>children</u> who <u>will</u> not betray me,' and he became their Saviour. ⁹ In all their troubles, it was no messenger or <u>angel</u> but his presence that saved them. In his love and pity he himself redeemed them, lifted them up and carried them throughout the days of old.

⁴⁶ And <u>Mary</u> said: My <u>soul</u> proclaims the greatness of the Lord
⁴⁷ and my <u>spirit</u> rejoices in <u>God</u> my Saviour; ⁴⁸ because he has looked upon the humiliation of his servant. Yes, from now onwards all generations <u>will</u> call me blessed, ⁴⁹ for the Almighty has done great things for me. Holy is his name,
⁵⁰ and his faithful love extends age after age to those who fear him. ⁵¹ He has used the power of his arm, he has routed the arrogant of heart. ⁵² He has pulled down princes from their thrones and raised high the lowly. ⁵³ He has filled the starving with good things, sent the rich away empty. ⁵⁴ He has come to the help of Israel his servant, mindful of his faithful love ⁵⁵ - according to the promise he made to our ancestors -- of his mercy to <u>Abraham</u> and to his descendants for ever.
