Daily Reading for Trinity Sunday - A

Reading 1, Exodus 34:4-6, 8-9

⁴ So he cut two tablets of stone like the first and, with the two tablets of stone in his hands, <u>Moses</u> went up Mount <u>Sinai</u> in the early morning as <u>Yahweh</u> had ordered. ⁵ And <u>Yahweh</u> descended in a cloud and stood with him there and pronounced the name Yahweh. ⁶ Then <u>Yahweh</u> passed before him and called out, 'Yahweh, Yahweh, <u>God</u> of tenderness and compassion, slow to anger, rich in faithful love and constancy, ⁸ Moses immediately bowed to the ground in worship, ⁹ then he said, 'If indeed I do enjoy your favour, please, my Lord, come with us, although they are an obstinate people; and forgive our faults and sins, and adopt us as your heritage.'

- ¹¹ To end then, brothers, we wish you joy; try to grow perfect; encourage one another; have a common <u>mind</u> and live in peace, and the <u>God</u> of love and peace <u>will</u> be with you.
- ¹² Greet one another with the holy kiss. All God's holy people send you their greetings.
- ¹³ The <u>grace</u> of the <u>Lord Jesus</u> Christ, the love of <u>God</u> and the fellowship of the <u>Holy Spirit</u> be with you all.

Gospel, *John 3:16-18*

- ¹⁶ For this is how <u>God</u> loved the world: he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but may have eternal life.
- ¹⁷ For <u>God</u> sent his Son into the world not to judge the world, but so that through him the world might be saved.
- ¹⁸ No one who believes in him <u>will</u> be judged; but whoever does not believe is judged already, because that <u>person</u> does not believe in the Name of God's only Son.
