¹⁵ The <u>Lord Yahweh Sabaoth</u> says this: Go and find that steward, Shebna, the master of the palace: ¹⁹ I shall hound you from your office, I shall snatch you from your post ²⁰ and, when that day comes, I shall summon my servant Eliakim son of Hilkiah. ²¹ I shall dress him in your tunic, I shall put your sash round his waist, I shall invest him with your authority; and he <u>will</u> be a father to the inhabitants of <u>Jerusalem</u> and to the House of Judah. ²² I shall place the key of David's palace on his shoulder; when he opens, no one <u>will</u> close, when he closes, no one <u>will</u> open. ²³ I shall drive him like a nail into a firm place; and he <u>will</u> become a <u>throne</u> of <u>glory</u> for his family.

Reading 2, Romans 11:33-36

³³ How rich and deep are the <u>wisdom</u> and the <u>knowledge</u> of God! We cannot reach to the root of his decisions or his ways. ³⁴ Who has ever known the <u>mind</u> of the Lord? Who has ever been his adviser? ³⁵ Who has given anything to him, so that his presents come only as a <u>debt</u> returned? ³⁶ Everything there is comes from him and is caused by him and exists for him. To him be <u>glory</u> for ever! Amen.

Gospel, Matthew 16:13-20

¹³ When <u>Jesus</u> came to the region of Caesarea <u>Philippi</u> he put this question to his disciples, 'Who do people say the Son of man is?'¹⁴ And they said, 'Some say John the Baptist, some Elijah, and others Jeremiah or one of the prophets.' ¹⁵ 'But you,' he said, 'who do you say I am?' ¹⁶ Then Simon Peter spoke up and said, 'You are the Christ, the Son of the living God.' ¹⁷ Jesus replied, 'Simon son of Jonah, you are a blessed man! Because it was no human agency that revealed this to you but my Father in heaven. ¹⁸ So I now say to you: You are Peter and on this rock I will build my community. And the gates of the underworld can never overpower it. ¹⁹ I will give you the keys of the kingdom of Heaven: whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven; whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.' ²⁰ Then he gave the disciples strict orders not to say to anyone that he was the Christ.
