## **Reading for September 8<sup>th</sup> The Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary**

## Reading 1, Romans 8:28-30

<sup>28</sup> We are well aware that <u>God</u> works with those who love him, those who have been called in accordance with his purpose, and turns everything to their good. <sup>29</sup> He decided beforehand who were the ones destined to be moulded to the pattern of his Son, so that he should be the eldest of many brothers; <sup>30</sup> it was those so destined that he called; those that he called, he justified, and those that he has justified he has brought into glory.

## Responsorial Psalm, Psalms 13:6, 6

<sup>6</sup> But I trust in your mercy, Grant my heart joy in your salvation. I will sing to the Lord, for he has dealt bountifully with me!

## Gospel, Matthew 1:1-16, 18-23

<sup>1</sup> Roll of the genealogy of <u>Jesus</u> Christ, son of David, son of Abraham: <sup>2</sup> Abraham fathered Isaac, <u>Isaac</u> fathered Jacob, <u>Jacob</u> fathered Judah and his brothers, <sup>3</sup> Judah fathered Perez and Zerah, whose mother was Tamar, Perez fathered Hezron, Hezron fathered Ram, <sup>4</sup> Ram fathered Amminadab, Amminadab fathered Nahshon, Nahshon fathered Salmon, <sup>5</sup> Salmon fathered Boaz, whose mother was Rahab, Boaz fathered Obed, whose mother was Ruth, Obed fathered Jesse; <sup>6</sup> and Jesse fathered King David. David fathered Solomon, whose mother had been Uriah's wife, <sup>7</sup> Solomon fathered Rehoboam, Rehoboam fathered Abijah, Abijah fathered Asa, <sup>8</sup> Asa fathered

Jehoshaphat, Jehoshaphat fathered Joram, Joram fathered Uzziah, <sup>9</sup> Uzziah fathered Jotham, Jotham fathered Ahaz, Ahaz fathered Hezekiah, <sup>10</sup> Hezekiah fathered Manasseh, Manasseh fathered Amon, Amon fathered Josiah; <sup>11</sup> and Josiah fathered Jechoniah and his brothers. Then the deportation to Babylon took place. <sup>12</sup> After the deportation to Babylon: Jechoniah fathered Shealtiel, Shealtiel fathered Zerubbabel, <sup>13</sup> Zerubbabel fathered Abiud, Abiud fathered Eliakim, Eliakim fathered Azor, <sup>14</sup> Azor fathered Zadok, Zadok fathered Achim, Achim fathered Eliud, <sup>15</sup> Eliud fathered Eleazar, Eleazar fathered Matthan, Matthan fathered Jacob; <sup>16</sup> and <u>Jacob</u> fathered <u>Joseph</u> the husband of Mary; of her was born Jesus who is called Christ.<sup>18</sup> This is how Jesus Christ came to be born. His mother Mary was betrothed to Joseph; but before they came to live together she was found to be with child through the Holy Spirit.<sup>19</sup> Her husband Joseph, being an upright man and wanting to spare her disgrace, decided to divorce her informally. <sup>20</sup> He had made up his <u>mind</u> to do this when suddenly the <u>angel</u> of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, 'Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because she has conceived what is in her by the Holy Spirit.<sup>21</sup> She will give birth to a son and you must name him Jesus, because he is the one who is to save his people from their sins.' <sup>22</sup> Now all this took place to fulfil what the Lord had spoken through the prophet: <sup>23</sup> Look! the virgin is with child and will give birth to a son whom they will call Immanuel, a name which means 'God-is-with-us'.
